- May still have a green collar on if it has not come off (although it is hard to see in furry neck hair).
- Small adult. Spayed female. Named "Natasha". Very loving.

- Needs special medicine.
- **Afraid of strangers and won't ask for help.**
- **Indoor-only cat!** Not aware of outdoor dangers!
- Extremely shy and easily frightened.
- **Scared and hiding;** will need to be coaxed out by us, so please call us immediately if you see her!
- Does not know how to mouse and **cannot survive on her own.**
- Very timid and will not approach people or houses for help.

- She needs help to be found! We are desperate to find her.
- Please watch out the window for her for MANY weeks, as she will be frightened & hiding!
- Please look in any possible hiding place such as in a shed, garage and under the house, in case she's injured, hiding or locked in.
